3. We could also use some help cleaning after school until we find someone for the position. Available?



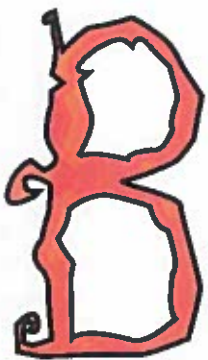

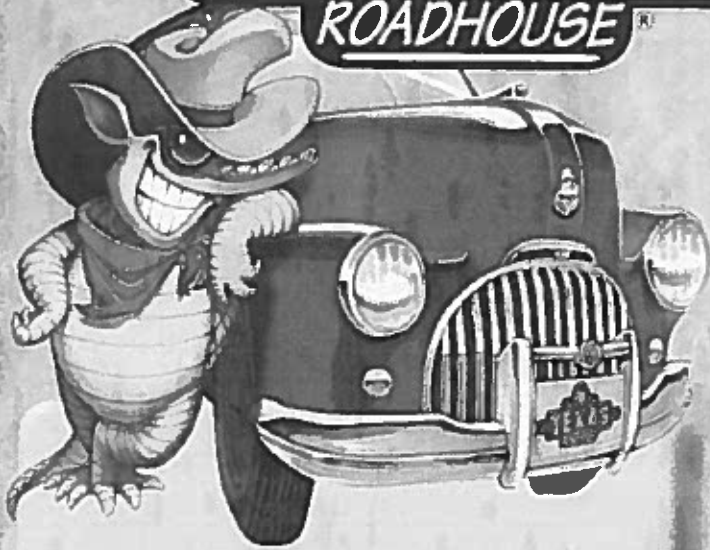
